Course Outline

This standalone module in Vascular Nursing is designed to develop the knowledge and skills of those who deliver care and promote the health interests of patients with vascular disease. The candidates undertaking this course will be equipped to work in specialist clinical settings relating to vascular nursing. It is aimed at enhancing skills, autonomy, responsibility and clinical accountability. It is aimed at practitioners who work across a variety of settings including hospitals, primary care, and community care where patients with vascular illnesses are cared for.

Structure and Delivery

Year One: commences with a full week in September and thereafter one day per week for the remainder of the academic year.

Year Two: attendance at workshops throughout the academic year. The course is offered on a two year part-time basis.

This course includes clinical and practice based teaching, learning and assessment and students may be required to attend additional sessions at associated service provider sites as well as at the student's practice base during year one of the course.
